AN ACT relative to qualifications for the commissioner of education.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Commissioner; Deputy Commissioner; Directors; Compensation. Amend RSA 21-N:3, I to read
2	as follows:
3	I. The governor, after consultation with the board of education, shall appoint the
4	commissioner and the deputy commissioner of the department of education with the consent of
5	council. Each shall serve for a term of 4 years. The commissioner and the deputy commissioner may
6	succeed himself or herself, if reappointed. The commissioner and deputy commissioner shall: [be
7	qualified to hold their positions by reason of education and experience.]
8	(a) Hold an advanced degree from an accredited college or university;
9	(b) Be certified as a teacher or as a school administrator; and
10	(c) Have at least 5 years combined experience in teaching or administration in a
11	public school.
12	2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
