IX-e. Require School Districts to Adopt a Policy on Parental Notification of Changes in  $\mathbf{5}$ Student's Mental and Emotional Well-Being, or Related Services. A school district may not adopt 6 7policies, procedures or student support forms that prohibit school district personnel from answering 8 questions from a parent about his or her student's mental, emotional, or physical health or well-9 being, sexuality, or a change in related services or monitoring, or that encourage or have the effect of 10 encouraging a student to withhold from a parent such information. School district personnel may 11 not discourage or prohibit parental notification of and involvement in critical decisions affecting a 12student's mental, emotional, or physical health or well-being. This paragraph does not prohibit a 13school district from adopting procedures that permit school personnel to withhold such information from a parent if a reasonably prudent person would believe that disclosure would result in abuse, 1415abandonment, or neglect pursuant to RSA 169-C:3.
