HOUSE BILL ***183-FN***

AN ACT relative to employment of retired firefighters at the fire academy.

SPONSORS: Rep. Wolf, Merr. 7; Rep. Bordes, Belk. 5; Rep. B. Boyd, Hills. 12

COMMITTEE: Executive Departments and Administration

ANALYSIS

This bill allows retired group II firefighter members of the retirement system to be employed by the New Hampshire fire academy and not have those employment hours count against the part-time hours limit.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Three

AN ACT relative to employment of retired firefighters at the fire academy.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Certain Part-Time Employment; Employment by the New Hampshire Fire
2 Academy; Exception. Amend RSA 100-A by inserting after section 7-b the following new section:

3 100-A:7-c Certain Part-Time Employment; Employment by the New Hampshire Fire Academy;
4 Exception. The annual limitations on part-time employment as defined in RSA 100-A:1, XXXIV
5 shall be modified for retired group II permanent firemen members to exclude any hours employed by
6 the department of safety at the New Hampshire fire academy. The department of safety shall
7 include hours worked by such retired group II permanent firefighters at the New Hampshire fire
8 academy as a separate entry in the report required in RSA 100-A:16, VII(a).

9 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

**HB 183-FN- FISCAL NOTE
AS INTRODUCED**

AN ACT relative to employment of retired firefighters at the fire academy.
