AN ACT relative to deadlines for candidates filing by nomination papers for state general

elections.

ANALYSIS

This bill changes the deadlines for candidates filing by nomination papers for state general elections.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Elections; Nominations by Primary; Filing by Other Candidates. Amend RSA 655-14-a to read as follows:

655:14-a Filing by Other Candidates. Every candidate for state or federal office who intends to have his name placed on the ballot for the state general election by means other than nomination by party primary shall file a declaration of intent with the secretary of state as provided in RSA 655:17-a or RSA 655:17-b [during the same time period in which party candidates file a declaration under RSA 655:14] no later than 5:00 p.m. on the third Monday of July of the year of the state general election.

- 2 Elections; Nominations by Papers; Certification. Amend RSA 655:41, I to read as follows: 655:41 Certification.
- I. Each nomination paper shall be submitted to the supervisors of the checklist of the town or ward in which the signer is domiciled or is registered, and a majority of the supervisors shall certify whether or not the signer is a registered voter in said town or ward. The supervisors of the checklist shall certify nomination papers under this section in a timely fashion, so that their certification shall be complete for each candidate, together with any objections to the nomination papers submitted, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the [Wednesday 2 weeks before the primary] Tuesday 10 weeks before the general election or 11 weeks before the general election if the primary election will occur 9 weeks before the general election. Each nomination paper shall be submitted to the supervisors of the checklist no later than 5:00 p.m. on the [Wednesday 5 weeks before the primary] Tuesday 13 weeks before the general election or 14 weeks before the general election if the primary election will occur 9 weeks before the general election.
 - 3 Elections; Nominations by Paper; Filing Deadline. Amend RSA 655:43, I to read as follows: 655:43 Filing Deadline.
- I. Nomination papers shall be filed with the secretary of state no later than 5:00 p.m. on the [Wednesday one week before the primary] Tuesday 9 weeks before the general election or 10 weeks before the general election if the primary election will occur 9 weeks before the general election. Nomination papers to be filed shall be grouped by municipality. No nomination papers shall be accepted by the secretary of state unless the candidate shall have met the age and domicile qualifications for the office he or she seeks at the time of the general election and meets all the other qualifications at the time of filing; and if a candidate for the office of governor, executive

- 2 papers an affidavit of qualifications as provided in RSA 655:28 and 655:29; and if a candidate for
