STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to the composition of the ethics oversight advisory committee.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 57:1 Ethics Oversight Advisory Committee. RSA 141-C:27, III is repealed and reenacted to read as
2 follows:

3 III. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

4 (a) Two members of the house of representatives, one of whom shall be from the minority
5 party, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. The speaker shall give preference to
6 those members who have been trained in ethics.

7 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the senate president. The senate president
8 shall give preference to a member who has been trained in ethics.

9 (c) The commissioner of the department of health and human services, or designee.

10 (d) The director of the department of health and human services, division of public health
11 services.

12 (e) The state epidemiologist.

13 (f) An attorney well-versed in medical ethics, appointed by the president of the New
14 Hampshire Bar Association.

15 (g) A physician well-versed in medical ethics, appointed by the president of the New
16 Hampshire Medical Society.

17 (h) The executive director of the governor's commission on disability, or designee.

18 (i) A nurse well-versed in medical ethics, appointed by the president of the New Hampshire
19 Board of Nursing.

20 (j) A psychologist well-versed in ethics, appointed by the president of the New Hampshire
21 Psychological Association.

22 (k) A professor of ethics currently teaching at a college or university in New Hampshire,
23 appointed by the chairperson elected in paragraph IV.

24 57:2 Ethics Oversight Advisory Committee. Amend RSA 141-C:27, IV to read as follows:

25 IV. The committee shall elect one of the legislative members as chairperson. Legislative
26 members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to the duties of the
27 committee. The committee shall meet initially within [30] **90** days of the effective date of this section and
28 then as regularly as the chairperson shall direct.

 57:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
