 RSA 664:4 by inserting after paragraph V the following new paragraph:
- 3 VI. By any person or business entity that has received any grant from the state of New
- 4 Hampshire in the last 2 years.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
