# STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two

AN ACT relative to the right of a victim of domestic violence to have a support person present when testifying or being deposed.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Protection of Persons from Domestic Violence; Commencement of 2 Proceedings; Hearing; Establishing Right to Support Person. Amend RSA 173-B:3 by inserting after 3 paragraph VIII the following new paragraph:

4 IX. A plaintiff in family court proceedings shall be permitted a support person outside the 5 presence of the defendant or the defendant's legal counsel. Such use of a support person shall not be

- 6 restricted by the presiding judge.
- 7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
