AN ACT modifying the authority and duties of the housing appeals board. Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened: 1 1 Housing Appeals Board. Amend RSA 679:5 to read as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ I. It shall be the duty of the board and it shall have power and authority to hear and affirm, 3 reverse, or modify, in whole or in part, appeals of final decisions of [municipal boards, committees, 4and commissions regarding questions of housing and housing development. This includes, but is not limited to: $\mathbf{5}$ 6 (a) Planning board decisions on subdivisions or site plans. 7(b) Board of adjustment decisions on variances, special exceptions, administrative 8 appeals, and ordinance administration. 9 (c) The use of innovative land use controls. 10(d) Growth management controls and interim growth management controls. (c) Decisions of historic district commissions, heritage commissions, and conservation 11 12commissions. 13(f) Other municipal permits and fees applicable to housing and housing developments. 14(g)] planning boards, zoning boards of adjustment, building code boards of appeals, historic district commissions, and heritage commissions on applications for the 15development of housing. Matters subject to the board's authority may include mixed-use 1617combinations of residential and nonresidential uses. Such different uses may occur on separate 18properties, provided such properties are all part of a common scheme of development. 192 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
