Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Hampshire Veterans' Home; Life Enhancement Dementia Unit Renamed the Barry E.
 2 Conway Unit. The life enhancement dementia unit of the New Hampshire veterans' home is hereby
 3 renamed the Barry E. Conway Unit.
- 4 2 Signage. The cost of design, construction, maintenance, and installation of any signage 5 required under section 1 of this act shall not be a cost to the state.
- 6 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
