AN ACT prohibiting the department of education and the state board of education from directing or limiting school instructional options, such as remote learning.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 School Performance and Accountability; Remote Learning. Amend RSA 193-H:5 to read as 2 follows:

3 193-H:5 Powers of the Department of Education. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to

4 permit either the department of education or the state board of education to take control of the daily

5 operations of any local public school. The department of education and the state board of

6 education are prohibited from directing or limiting the implementation by school boards of

7 school instructional options including remote learning.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
