Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Establishment of Local Land Use Boards; Membership. Amend RSA 673:1, I to read as 2 follows: 3 I. Any local legislative body may establish a planning board[, the members of which shall be 4 residents of the municipality]. 5 2 New Paragraph; Establishment of Local Land Use Boards; Membership. Amend RSA 673:1 by 6 inserting after paragraph V the following new paragraph: 7 VI. Voting members of any local land use board established pursuant to paragraphs I, II, or 8 IV, and of a building code board of appeals established pursuant to paragraph V, including ex officio 9 members, shall be residents of the municipality in which they serve.
  - 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
