1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to administration of the state immunization registry.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

7 1 New Paragraph; Communicable Disease; Immunization Registry; Opportunity to Opt-out or
8 Opt-in to the Registry. Amend RSA 141-C:20-f by inserting after paragraph II the following new
9 paragraph:

10 II-a. Each patient, or the patient's parent or guardian if the patient is a minor, shall be
11 given the opportunity to opt-out or opt-in to the immunization registry. No patient's personal data,
12 such as name, address, date of birth, immunization, or vaccination information, shall be entered into
13 the registry without the explicit, written or electronic consent of the patient, or the patient's parent
14 or guardian.

15 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill requires a patient to have the opportunity to opt-out or opt-in to the immunization registry. The bill also provides that a patient's personal data shall not be entered into the registry without their explicit consent.
