This bill prohibits a sentence of life imprisonment without parole for a juvenile convicted as an adult of homicide.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Section; Homicide; Life Imprisonment Without Parole Prohibited for Juveniles. Amend
 2 RSA 630 by inserting after section 6 the following new section:
 3 630:7 Life Imprisonment Without Parole Prohibited for Juveniles. No juvenile convicted as an
 4 adult for an offense under this chapter shall be sentenced to life imprisonment without the
 5 possibility for parole.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2022.
