AN ACT relative to the seating of delegates to national party conventions.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Delegates to National Party Conventions. Amend RSA 653:5 to read as follows:

2 653:5 Delegates to National Party Conventions. At every presidential primary election, the

3 voters of the state shall vote their preference for party candidates for president and thereby choose

4 the delegates to each presidential nominating convention to which the state is entitled. *The New* 

5 Hampshire delegates so selected shall be seated and have complete voting rights at any

6 national party nominating convention.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
