HOUSE BILL            **624-FN**

AN ACT                relative to federal immigration checkpoints.

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ANALYSIS

This bill requires a law enforcement agency to provide public notice of an immigration checkpoint.

AN ACT                      relative to federal immigration checkpoints.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 New Section; Immigration Checkpoints. Amend RSA 265 by inserting after section 1-c the  
2 following new section:

3            265:1-d Immigration Checkpoints. When any state, county, or municipal police department or  
4 law enforcement agency is informed by a federal agency of intent to conduct an immigration  
5 checkpoint, the department or agency shall give notice to the public within 24 hours of when the  
6 checkpoint is scheduled to occur or as soon as is practical. The notice shall disclose, if known, the  
7 date, municipality, and geographical area in which the checkpoint will occur. Notice to the public  
8 shall be provided by using various media resources available, which may include publishing this  
9 information on the government agency's website and on social media, or the use of press conferences,  
10 press releases, radio and television coverage, posters, and flyers.

11           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
