AN ACT relative to polycystic ovary syndrome awareness.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Polycystic Ovary Syndrome Awareness Day. Amend RSA 4 by inserting after 2 section 13-cc the following new section:

3 4:13-dd Polycystic Ovary Syndrome Awareness Day. The governor shall annually issue a

4 proclamation calling for the proper observance of March 2 as Polycystic Ovary Syndrome ("PCOS")

5 Awareness Day, a day to support those individuals who suffer from polycystic ovary syndrome and to

6 raise awareness of the medical condition.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
