Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

59:1 Change of School or Assignment; Best Interest of Student. Amend RSA 193:3, III-a, (e) to read

as follows:

(e) The state board of education shall adopt rules, pursuant to RSA 541-A, relative to manifest educational hardship. Each school board shall establish a policy, consistent with the state board's rules, which shall allow a school board, with the recommendation of the superintendent, to take appropriate action including assignment to another public school, [er] public academy, *or approved private*

school within the district or to a public school, [er] public academy, or approved private school in another

district.

59:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
