Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Employment of Undocumented Workers Prohibited; E-Verify. Amend RSA 275-A:4-a to read 2 as follows: 3 275-A:4-a Employment of Undocumented Workers Prohibited. No employer may employ any 4 employee without obtaining documentation showing the employee's eligibility to work in the United States. If the employer has 25 or more employees, the employer shall verify employment 5 6 eligibility through the E-Verify system of the United States Citizenship and Immigration 7 Services. The employer shall maintain such documentation for the period required by federal law. 8 Acceptable documentation of eligibility to work in the United States shall include documents 9 required by federal law or supporting documentation that satisfies the requirement of federal law.
- 10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2025.
