### STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Four

AN ACT relative to immunization requirements for child care agencies.

4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Immunization; Optional for Child Care Agency. Amend RSA 141-C:20-a, II to read as follows: 2 II. No child shall be admitted or enrolled in any school [or child care agency, public or 3 private, unless the following is demonstrated: 4 (a) Immunization under paragraph I; 5 (b) Partial immunization relative to the age of the child as specified in rules adopted by 6 the commissioner; or 7 (c) Exemption under RSA 141-C:20-c. 8 2 Records. Amend RSA 141-C:20-b, II to read as follows: 9 Schools [and child care agencies] shall keep immunization records for all enrolled 10 children. Such records shall be available for inspection during reasonable hours upon request by the 11 commissioner or his designee. 12 3 Immunization Reports. Amend RSA 141-C:20-e to read as follows: 13 141-C:20-e Immunization Reports. Schools [and child care agencies, whether public or private,] 14 shall make an annual report to the commissioner relative to the status of immunization of all enrolled children. 15
