Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 Immunization; Definition of Noncommunicable Disease. Amend RSA 141-C:20-a, III to read

- 3 III. Nothing in this section shall require an immunization/vaccination requirement for 4 diseases that are noncommunicable, *other than tetanus*. Noncommunicable disease means a 5 disease that is not [infectious or] transmissible from person-to-person.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
