

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 187, relative to the emergency powers of the commissioner of
2 health and human services and relative to the membership of the oversight committee on health and
3 human services.

5 Recommendation:

6 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrency with the Senate amendment, and
7 concur with the Senate amendment, and

8 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
9 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10

11 Amend RSA 21-P:53, VIII and IX as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing them with the
12 following:

13

14 ***VIII. As soon as practicable, the commissioner shall notify the speaker of the house***
15 ***of representatives, the senate president, the chair of the house committee on health, human***
16 ***services and elderly affairs and the chair of the senate committee on health and human***
17 ***services of the impending issuance of emergency orders under this section and provide a***
18 ***description of such orders.***

19 ***IX. The legislature may terminate an emergency order issued under this chapter by***
20 ***a majority vote of both the senate and the house of representatives. A majority vote shall***
21 ***consist of a majority of members present and voting in each chamber acting separately.***
22 ***The commissioner's power to renew an emergency order under this chapter shall terminate***
23 ***upon a majority vote of both chambers under this section; provided, however, that such vote***
24 ***shall not preclude the commissioner from issuing a new emergency order during the state***
25 ***of emergency for different circumstances.***
