

Amendment to SB 136

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT prohibiting the employment or volunteering of a revoked or suspended educator, and  
4 repealing the graduation requirement of filing a Free Application for Federal Student  
5 Aid (FAFSA).

7 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 2 with the following:

9 3 Repeals; Free Application for Federal Student Aid; Graduation Requirements. The following  
10 are repealed:

11 I. 2021, 209:2, Part I, sections 1 and 2, adding the Free Application for Federal Student Aid  
12 (FAFSA) to graduation requirements.

13 II. RSA 193-E:3, I(o), relative to education reports on completing a Free Application for  
14 Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form.

15 4 Effective Date.

16 I. Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

17 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect June 30, 2023.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the hiring or service of a person by a school administrative unit, school district, chartered public school, or nonpublic school who is listed on the department of education's list of revoked and suspended educators. This bill also repeals the addition of the requirement for filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form for high school graduation.
