AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill prohibits the hiring or service of a person by a school administrative unit, school district, chartered public school, or nonpublic school who is listed on the department of education's list of revoked and suspended educators. This bill also allows a student exemption from the requirement for filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form for high school graduation.
