AN ACT requiring the teaching of cursive handwriting and multiplication tables.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Cursive Handwriting and Memorization of Multiplication Tables. RSA 189:11-c is repealed 2 and reenacted to read as follows: 3 189:11-c Cursive Handwriting and Memorization of Multiplication Tables. Each public school 4 district and chartered public school shall: 5 (a) Provide instruction in cursive writing by the end of fifth grade as a component of 6 English language arts; and 7 (b) Provide instruction of the multiplication tables by the end of fifth grade; and 8 (c) Subparagraphs (a) and (b) may be accommodated, modified, or waived in accordance 9 with a student's Individual Education Program (IEP) or 504 Plan.
- 10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
