Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Section; Insurance Companies and Agents; Mandatory Disclosure of Policy Limits. 2 Amend RSA 402 by inserting after section 84 the following new section: 3 402:85 Mandatory Disclosure of Policy Limits. 4 I. Upon written request by a claimant or the claimant's attorney, an insurer doing business 5 in this state shall provide the claimant or the claimant's attorney with the liability coverage limits of 6 that insurer's insured. The insurer shall provide the liability coverage limits within 60 days of 7 receipt of the written request. 8 II. An insurer who fails to comply with this section is subject to a penalty of \$500, plus 9 reasonable attorney's fees and expenses incurred in obtaining the liability coverage limits.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2025.

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
