



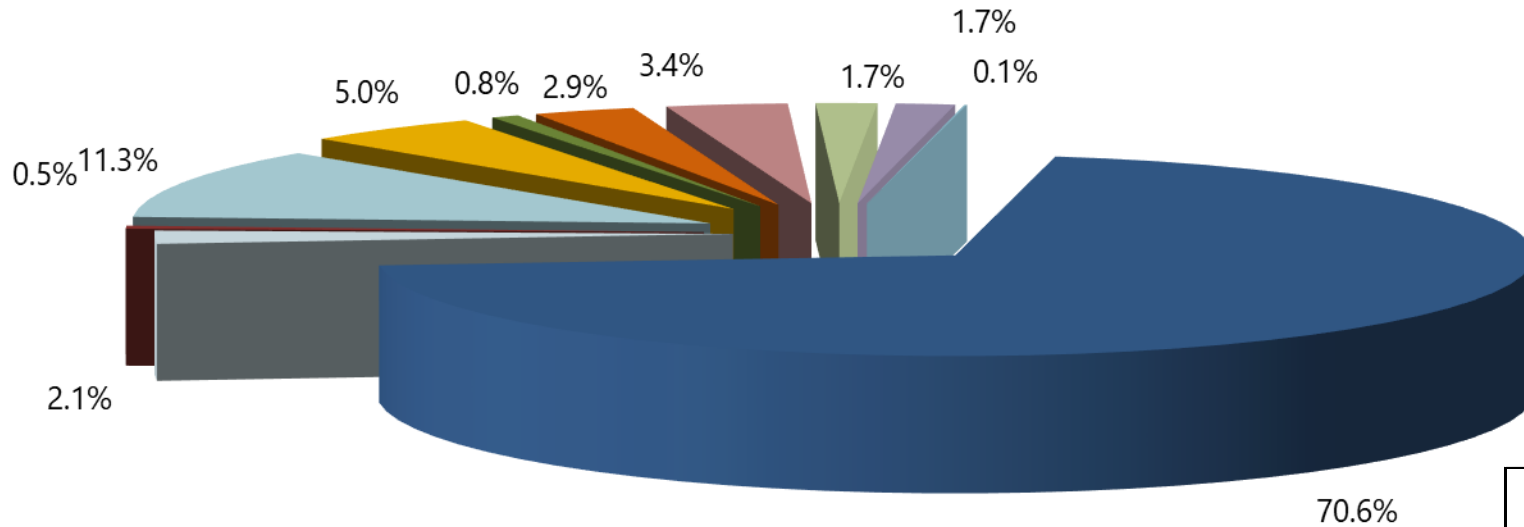

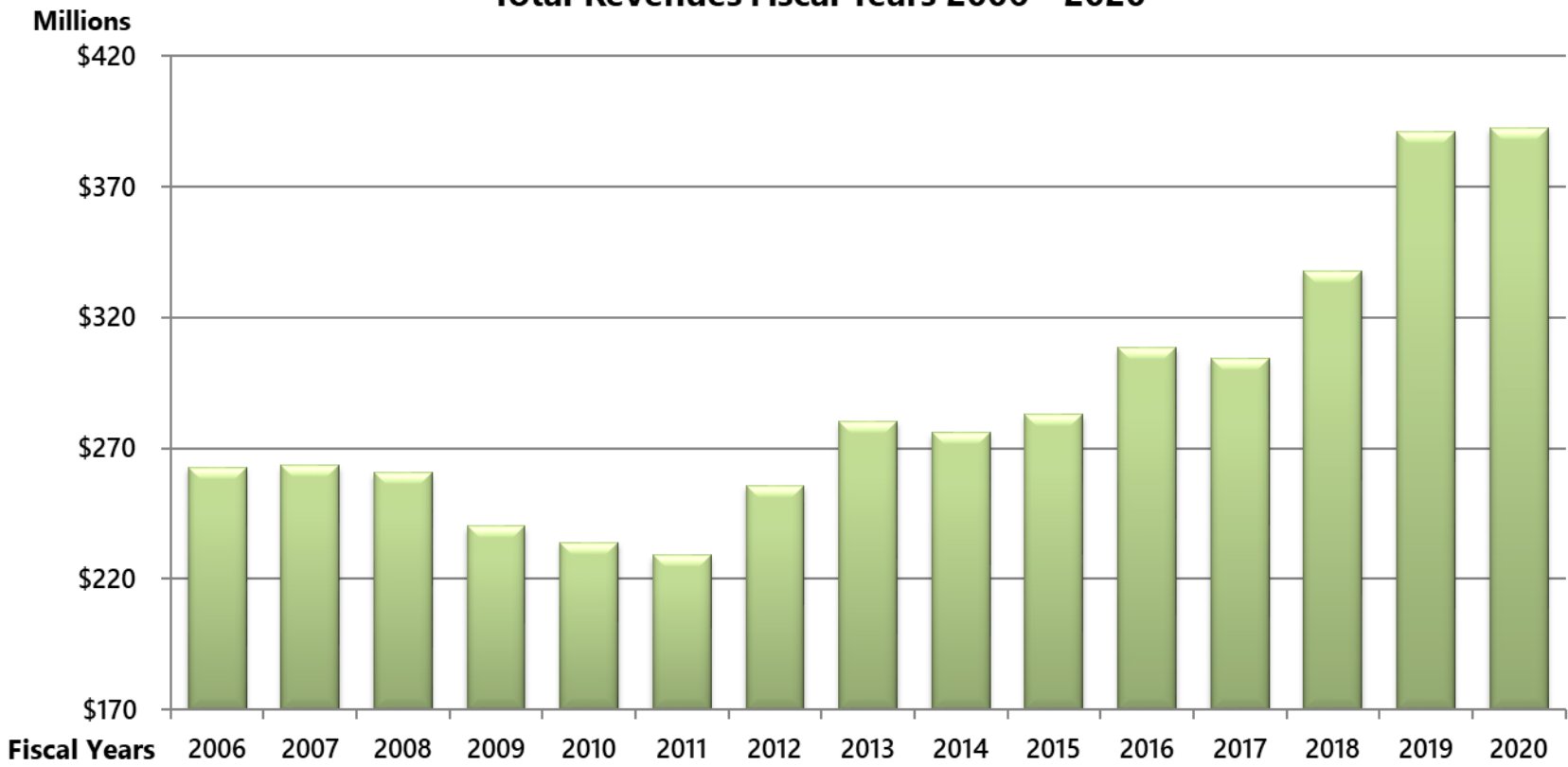
Sales by Game Last 10 Fiscal Years



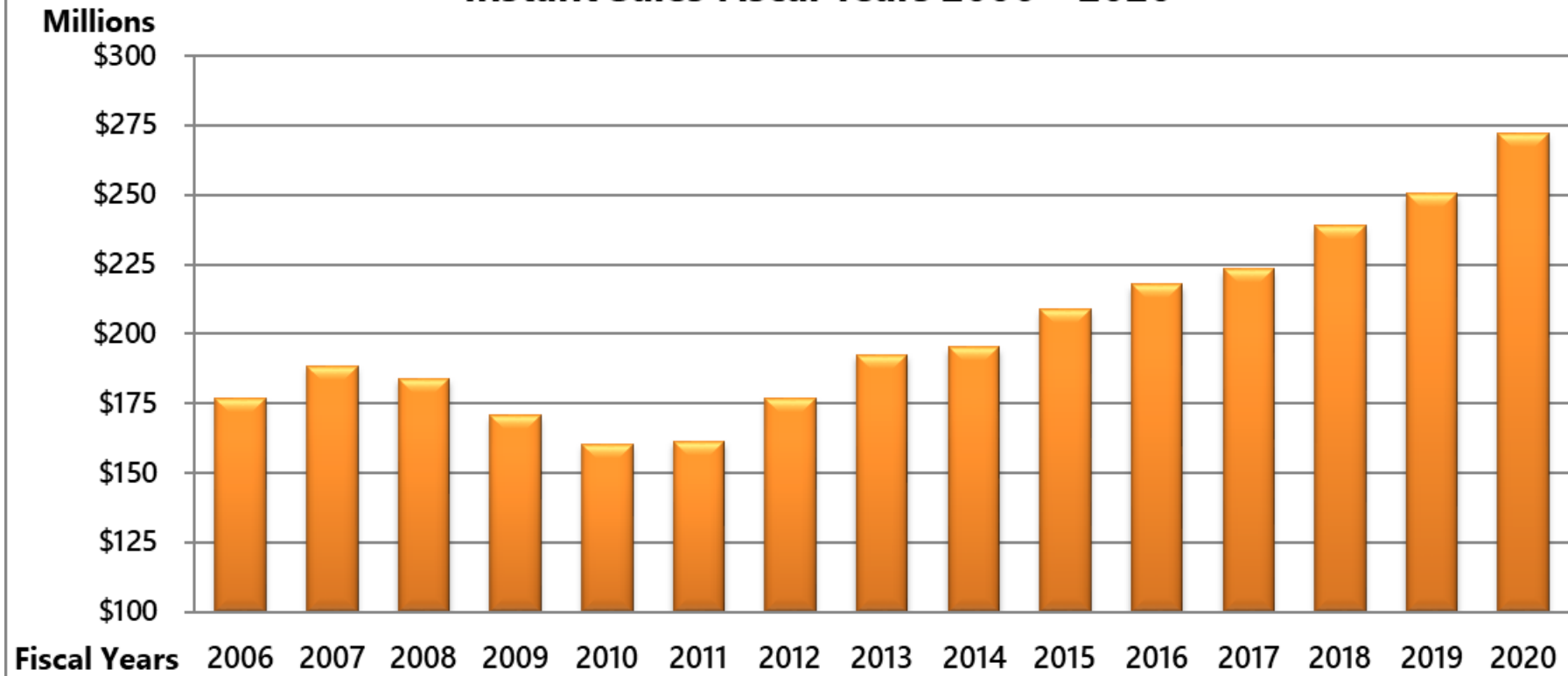

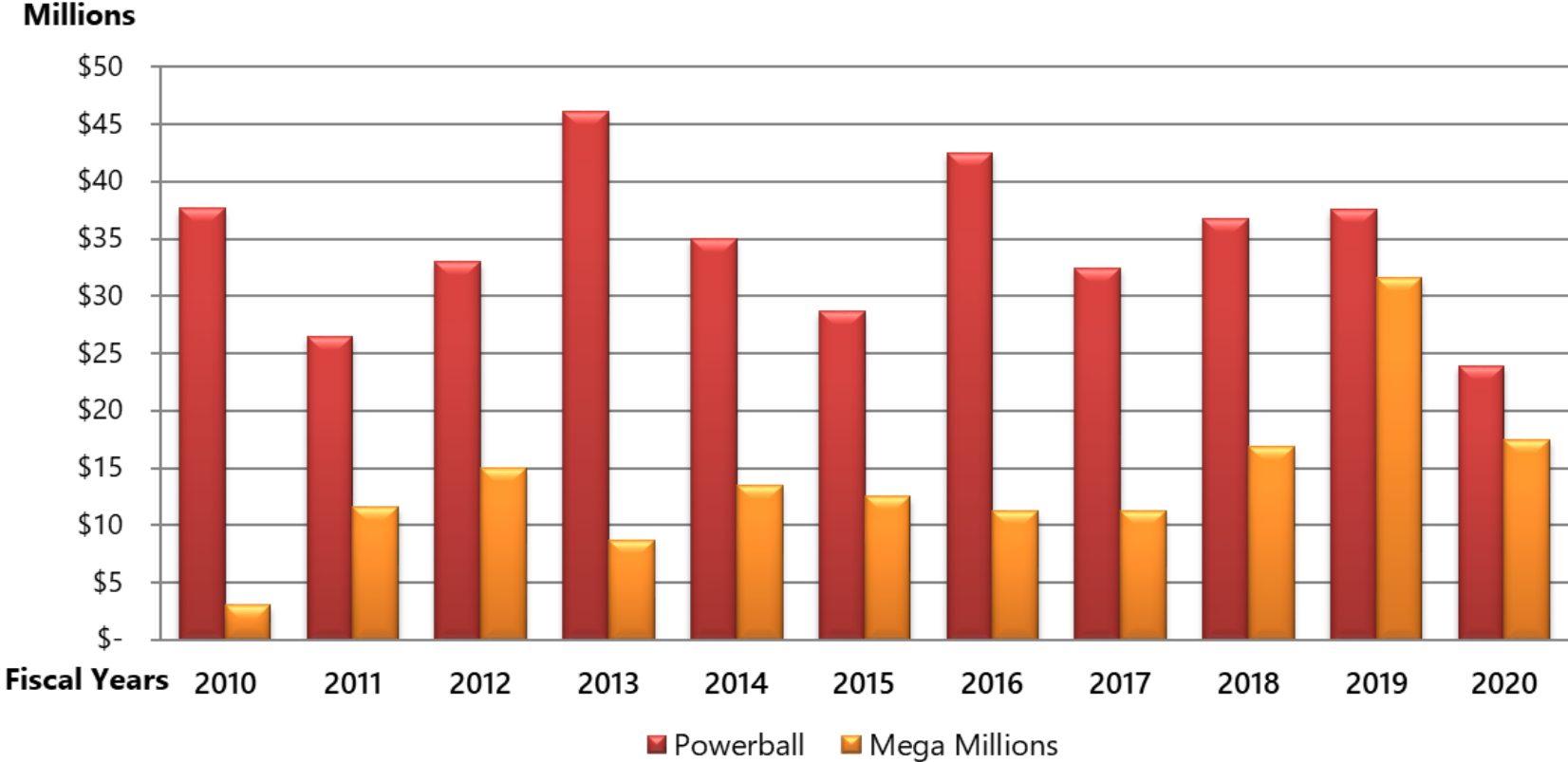
Total Revenues Fiscal Years 2006 – 2020
