Mission & Vision Statements

Mission

To provide care and compassion for citizens with severe and persistent mental illness whom require inpatient psychiatric care.

Vision

New Hampshire Hospital will become a model of inpatient psychiatric care in the state and region, rapidly stabilizing psychiatric symptoms, and ensuring patients can return to their home communities and thrive.



- New Hampshire Hospital provides acute, inpatient psychiatry to citizens experiencing severe and persistent mental illness.
- The original campus of New Hampshire Hospital was planned in 1836, and opened in 1841.
 - In 1841 census was 312 patients
 - In 1955 census exceeded 2,700 patients
 - The current census capacity is 154 patients
 - The total capacity, if adequately staffed, is 184 patients
- Patients admitted to New Hampshire Hospital must meet two criteria:
 - They must be a danger to themselves or others
 - They must have a clearly diagnosed mental health condition





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Delivery System- The Inpatient Mental Health System




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Common Diagnoses

- New Hampshire Hospital has 660 full-time positions split across 3 shifts, 7 days per week (these figures exclude PATH, accounting unit 6096).
- A significant portion of the Hospital's staff are in direct care roles such as Nurses, Mental Health Workers, Psychologists, Occupational Therapists, and other clinical roles.


Workload Benchmarks

 - Patient characteristics
 - Patient acuity
- These contextual parameters are published by authoritative bodies, and are often built into regulatory standards.




Inpatient Psychiatry Referrals- Adults



Referrals for adult inpatient psychiatry has remained relatively flat throughout the years.




Inpatient Psychiatry Waitlist- Adults



The significant drop in the middle of 2021 is mostly a result of added adult capacity at NHH when children and adolescents were no longer admitted (Hampstead). 14



Inpatient Psychiatry Emergency Department Boarding- Adults




This data includes all emergency room boarding days, including patients who boarded, but did not end up coming to New Hampshire Hospital.

Staffing challenges resulted in the closing of two units that are slated to reopen over the FY24-25 biennium. This will allow the census to again exceed 180.




Adult Inpatient Psychiatry Summary

- 1. Adult demand (referrals) has remained relatively steady
- 2. The adult inpatient psychiatry waitlist has grown
- 3. Adult emergency room boarding has increased
- 4. On any given day, approximately 50% of patients at New Hampshire Hospital are "non-certified", meaning they do not meet the criteria for a billable stay, and could be better served in a less restrictive environment.





Front Door

- Adult emergency room boarding
- Enhancing transparency & coordination among statewide DRFs (Designated Receiving Facilities)

Back Door

- Capacity to discharge to group homes
- Capacity to discharge to transitional housing
- Capacity to discharge to long-term care
- Capacity to discharge forensic patients to a more appropriate setting

Operational & Financial

- Recruitment and retention
 - Professional Development
 - Wages
 - Current Vacancy Rates
- Aging furniture
- Aging building & infrastructure
- Commercial Insurance Carriers



Forensic Hospital (NHFH)

- Construction anticipated to start spring 2023
- Estimated completion in summer of 2025
- Occupancy fall of 2025 with a capacity of 24 beds
