1. The meeting was convened at 9:00 a.m. by Rep. McGuire as Chair.

The Board had submitted a conditional approval request in a letter and amended rule dated July 20, 2016.

Rep. Schmidt moved that the Committee accept the conditional approval request and conditionally approve Proposed Interim Rule INT 2016-17 based on the request.

Adopted.

5. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2016-2 from the Board of Psychologists (Organizational Rules, Practice and Procedure, License and Registration Requirements, Applications and Fees, Continued Status, Ethical Standards, Responsibilities of Psychologists, and Professional Misconduct). Robert Lamberti from the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification testified for the Board.

Sen. Reagan moved that the Committee postpone action on Final Proposal 2016-2 to the regular Committee meeting on August 18, 2016 and request a waiver from the Director of the Office of Legislative Services of the Committee's deadline of July 28, 2016 to act on the Final Proposal.

6. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2016-10 from the Board of Licensure for Land Surveyors (Rules Regarding Licensure Requirements; Disciplinary Matters, Continued Status, Ethical Standards and Research Standards). Robert Lamberti from the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification testified for the Board.

The Board had submitted a conditional approval request in a letter and amended rule dated July 19, 2016.

Sen. Reagan moved that the Committee conditionally approve Final Proposal 2016-10 based on the request.

7. The Committee discussed Final Proposal 2016-3 from the Public Employer Labor Relations Board (Election of Exclusive Representative, Additional Criteria for Determining Appropriate Bargaining Units). Douglas Ingersoll testified for the Board.

Sen. Watters moved that the Committee approve Final Proposal 2016-3 with the understanding that the Board would begin rulemaking this September to create rules describing, or incorporating by reference, all the forms used by the Board.

Sen. Reagan moved that the Committee conditionally approve Final Proposal 2016-50 on the condition that Pda 603.11(b) be amended to add at the end of the paragraph the sentence: "The service and

consumption of alcohol pursuant to such a contract shall comply with the relevant provisions of RSA 178, RSA 179, Liq 400, Liq 500, and Liq 700."
