Sen. Bradley continues his support for clean water projects

CONCORD, NH – The Senate Finance Committee today held a hearing on omnibus legislation that includes two clean water bills sponsored by Senate Majority Leader Jeb Bradley (R-Wolfeboro). Both pieces of legislation are a continuation of Bradley’s past environmental efforts to keep our water clean by funding drinking water and wastewater projects.

“Both of these bills are very important in protecting New Hampshire’s unique environment. It is essential that we be good stewards of our treasured natural resources including clean water,” said Bradley, “The funding also fulfills the on-going commitment for state aid drinking water grants and helps to protect local property taxpayers.”

Bradley’s bills are part of SB127 and make appropriation requests to the Department of Environmental Services for \$1M to fund public water system projects and \$12.6M for eligible wastewater projects starting in 2022. The appropriation for public water systems would be the first new grant in ten years under RSA 486 that covers aid to municipalities for water pollution control.
