Senate President Morse statement on Governor’s Budget Address

CONCORD, NH – Senate President Chuck Morse (R-Salem) issued the following statement today in response to Governor Chris Sununu’s FY22-23 Budget Address:

“I fully support the governor’s proposal to help our struggling Main Street businesses, hardworking families and property taxpayers recover from the pandemic. Lowering taxes will help people get back to work and grow our economy while providing additional assistance to cities and towns will help struggling property taxpayers.”

“Restoring the strong economy New Hampshire enjoyed prior to the pandemic is a top priority for Republicans because we know that a strong economy is the best way to protect taxpayers. I applaud the governor for pledging to lower the tax rates currently paid on the BET, Interest and Dividends, and Meals & Rooms taxes as well as increasing the amount of support the state sends to our municipalities. I believe these tax reductions will create the roadmap we need for building and sustaining a strong economy in New Hampshire.”

“Now that the governor has laid out his priorities for the next two years, the Senate is ready to work with our colleagues in the House to create a state budget that is fiscally sound, lives within our means and takes care of our state’s most vulnerable citizens.
