House and Senate Election Committee chairmen issue joint statement on redistricting plan for the state's two U.S. Congressional Districts (SB 200)

“We are pleased to announce that we have been working on a redistricting plan for our two U.S. Congressional Districts that is both constitutional and fair. In our opinion, the map that we have created honors both of those important goals. We look forward to publicly reviewing it on Monday, May 16 during our Committee of Conference on SB 200 that is scheduled for 11:00am in Statehouse, Room 100.”
