Senate votes to support feasibility study for building a pier at Hampton Beach

CONCORD, NH – Senator Kevin Avard (R-Nashua) issued the following statement today regarding Senate passage of bi-partisan SB 346, regarding a feasibility study for a pier at Hampton Beach directly south of the Boar's Head area:

“Hampton Beach is an amazing jewel on our Seacoast and is considered one of the best beaches in the country. Building a pier there would only make it better. I’m proud to be the prime sponsor of SB 346 and thank the Senate for getting on board with this feasibility study. A pier would not only enhance the Hampton experience, but it would also be fully accessible to handicapped and disabled visitors, which is absolutely the right thing to do. I look forward to SB 346 passing the House and gaining the Governor’s signature allowing the Hampton Beach Area Commission to begin work on the study with a strong focus on the impact of this important project.”
